Boise Senior High School is the oldest of the five public high schools in Boise, ID, and is located near the downtown

of approximately 1,549 students; the scholastic year is divided into two 18-week semesters. Boise High School is consistently placed among the top state and national rankings by U.S. News & World Report and Washington Post magazine.
